Ms. Keller was also named to *Lawdragon's* 2017 guide of the "100 Most Powerful Employment Lawyers" which is produced in partnership with *Human Resource Executive* and features leading corporate, defense-side employment lawyers.

Inclusion in both guides is based on editorial research, law firm submissions and online nominations.

Ms. Keller, President and COO of Baker Donelson, is one of two Tennessee-based attorneys included in the *Lawdragon* 500 guide and one of three Tennessee-based attorneys in the "100 Most Powerful Employment Lawyers" guide. An employment litigator in the Firm's Johnson City office, she advises clients on a wide variety of issues including discipline and terminations, benefits issues, leave, disability accommodation, policy formulation and enforcement, and similar matters.
